Those bonsai enthusiasts who enjoy creating display arrangements, should already be embracing the cold mountain landscapes. Not so far from home, the Langdale Pikes in Cumbria are the backdrop to this scene which features a larch 42cm from the collection of Darren Turner.

First falls of snow on high peaks is a common topic for winter bonsai display. This compact/cosy arrangement might offer a sensation of warmth and protection aided by a tiny Wabi-Shack.

We are now seeing many larch bonsai in Northern Europe that have been subject to decades of refinement that has resulted in stunning detail ramification. When larch has reached this stage, they become ideal subjects to exhibit in their leafless phase. Without details, these trees often look clumsy and irregular and are only suitable for display with their canopy of bright green needle like leaves.

Thanks to tireless dedication and perseverance, we will now be enjoying superb high quality Japanese and European larch bonsai, **through all the seasons** at many public bonsai events.
